 - a) Safely gain access to escalator and moving walk areas
 - b) Safe operation of escalators

- 11. Safely operate lifting platforms taking into account all safety precaution/practices and follow established procedures
 - a) Safely gain access to workplace and equipment

 - c) Manually operate platform lift equipment
