Detail

It has come to our attention that a S21 Piccolo Lift, Floor Assembly manufactured in 1991 has had some weld failures along the floor stiffener 'top hat' section where it attaches to the underside of the floor pan. 10 out of the 56 welds had failed. The purpose of this bulletin is to request that upon any individual Lift's routine inspection that the floor stiffeners are inspected for weld failures and the findings reported to Pete Jeffery at Stannah Lifts Ltd 01264 339090.

At present we know this as an isolated occurrence and we want to confirm this with the site surveillance. If any welds are found to be broken the floor pan is to be fixed to the stiffener using a CSK rivet under the floor covering.
