STANNAH 250/260 STAIRLIFTS WITH CURVED RAILS

There have been a few instances of the top or bottom support leg weld failing at the point where it joins the rail. As a result, we have developed a simple clamp which can be fitted to strengthen these points and a global upgrade programme has commenced.

Please find attached Safety Notices PDN 08/5775 and PDN 08/5759. The latter provides photographs to assist in identifying the particular rail design that requires the clamp upgrade.



Important Safety Upgrade on New Stannah Curved Stairlifts Installed between June 2001 and June 2007

Background

There have been a very small number of weld failures between the rail and the support leg. Each 250/260 curved stairlift has twin rails and five or more support legs. In most cases a failure of a weld between one of the rails and a leg will have no discernible consequence for a user. However in certain circumstances, if the weld fails between the top rail and either the first and last support leg, the rail can flex and the chair can tip forward.

Details of Failure Mode

Stannah has developed a simple safety upgrade kit to strengthen the first and last support legs. The complete installation can be completed in approximately 30 minutes. All parts and detailed fitting instructions are supplied in the safety upgrade kit.




Differences in 250/260 leg types

Since the introduction of the model 250 in 1997 to present day four types of leg design have been in production. The new clamp is only required for products manufactured between June 2001 to March 2007.


The images below show leg designs from 1997-2008. Only image 3 is suitable for the new clamp.
