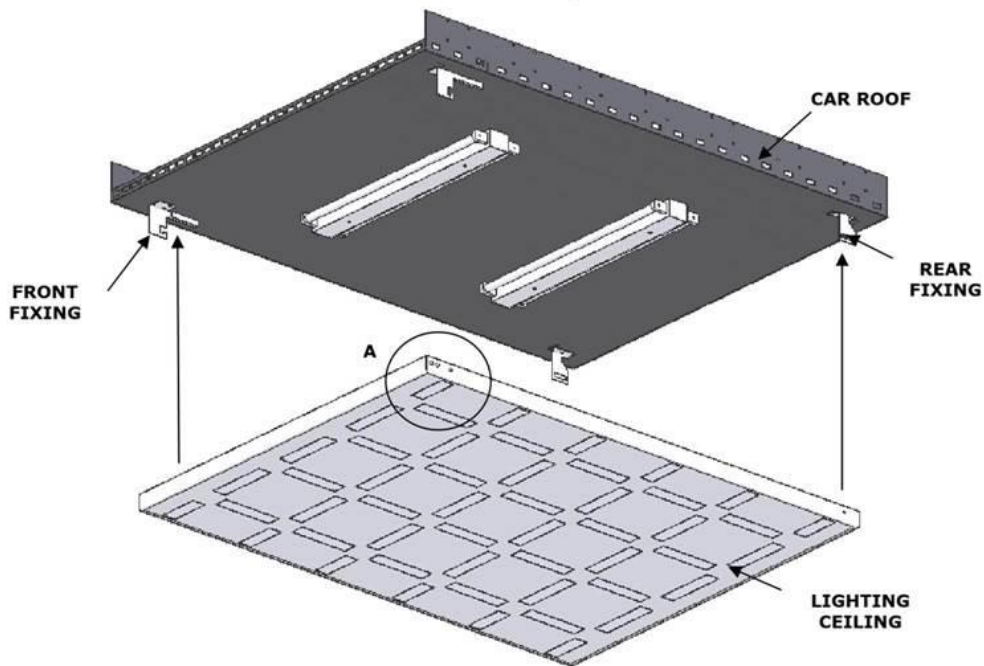
Background

All, we have had 3 incidents over a three-year period with false ceiling falling with MP lifts. We don't believe they fall independently. Something such as furniture being moved in the lift car pushes the false ceiling back and it slips out of the fixing brackets (see diagram below). The rubber stoppers would prevent this movement. MP have advised that their lifts are provide from the factory with black rubber 'stoppers'. See pictures attached.

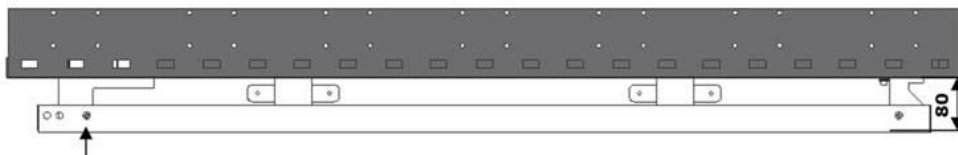
We believe this is happening – installers and/or service engineers are removing these stoppers when cleaning the ceiling or changing lights and failing to replace the rubber stoppers.

False Ceiling Diagram below from the Installation Manual:

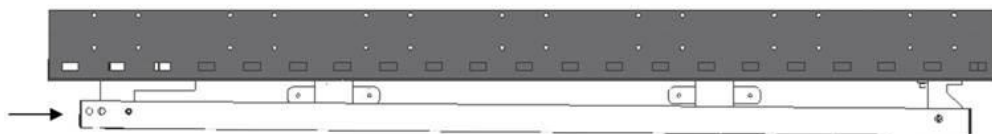
16.5. OPENING OF FOLDING LIGHTING CEILING, HEIGHT 80 mm



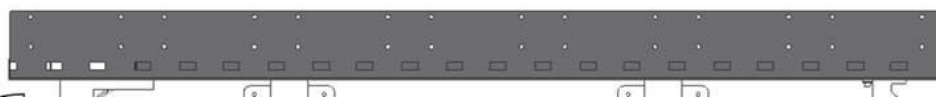
STEP 1: REMOVE THE SAFETY STOPPER



STEP 2: SMOOTHLY PUSH THE GRATING UPWARDS TO THE END



STEP 3: PUSH THE GRATING TOWARDS THE REAR PART

Actions:

1. The MP false ceiling must have the stoppers in place;
2. If removed at any time during installation – they must be replaced;
3. If removed at any time during service – they must be replaced;
